St. Ninian's Session Clerk Team continue to engage with the Presbytery on behalf of St. Ninian's Kirk Session and congregation over the Presbytery Plan Consultation.

Last Sunday, 19th June, the Team met with representatives from St. Andrew's Clermiston and St. Anne's to discuss the Consultation. The representatives from all three congregations agreed that further discussion between them should take place over the summer to consider whether at some point in the future the creation of a single charge involving all three congregations would be a better option for mission in west Edinburgh than the creation of a single charge involving only two of those congregations.

The next meeting between the representatives of these congregations will take place at the end of July, and a further update will be available then.
